



**Tobermory, Canada
August 25 - 26, 2022**

Welcome to Tobermory, the Scuba Diving Capital of Canada!

Tobermory is a harbor village on the Bruce Peninsula in the province of Ontario. Just southeast, Bruce Peninsula National Park is known for the Bruce Trail footpath on the craggy Niagara Escarpment, and the Grotto, a wave-carved cave in Georgian Bay. The village lies next to Fathom Five National Marine Park, a National Marine Conservation Area in the Georgian Bay section of Lake Huron that seeks to protect and display shipwrecks and lighthouses, and conserve freshwater ecosystems.

Discover the world below the waves of the Fathom Five National Marine Park, home to more than 20 shipwrecks. Immerse yourself in the captivating history of century old ships and catch a glimpse of their haunting beauty.

Divers will be diving from the Laura J. a 45' custom steel dive boat with spacious aft deck, comfortable cabin, and fin friendly deep boarding ladder. In addition, a local DM will join us to ensure we see the detail of each dive site.

The diving in Lake Huron in early June is cold, however, we will have good visibility. Every diver should have experience diving cold water and have the proper dive equipment to handle cold water. The average surface water

temperature will be between 43 and 50 degrees. We will be diving between 20 - 120ft. Dry-suit and Deep Certifications are recommended. If you have any questions, please contact AAO before signing up.

Cost: \$450 per diver.

PACKAGE INCLUDES:

• Two full day charters. Charters are 3 or 4 dives per day depending on the dive site destination, timing, and weather. All scheduling will be communicated by the boat Captain.

PACKAGE EXCLUDES:

• All dive gear, air fills, park dive tags (\$15-\$20), travel, meals, and lodging.

Please note - we recommend that each diver brings everything they need to dive with them to Tobermory. Divers will need to book their own lodging at local motels or local campgrounds.

Full payment must be made at the time of reservation. Payments are to be made by check to Aquatic Adventures Ohio and mailed to 3940 Lyman Drive, Hilliard, OH 43026. Payments made by credit card will be subject to a 3% processing fee.
